

Teachers assure all help in SSC exams

Grants to be raised to 100 pc in phases: Sircar

The leaders of Bangladesh Teacher's Association (Ashraf Nazrul), Bangladesh Shikhhkha Pratisthan Employee's Federation and Bangladesh Madrasa Teacher's Association had a meeting with Education Minister Barrister Jamiruddin Sircar at the Conference Room of the Ministry on Sunday, according to an official handout, reports BSS.

The demands of the associations were discussed in the meeting. There are ten committees with the representatives of

different teacher's associations which are working to resolve the problems of the non-governmental teachers and some committees have already prepared reports which will be finalised through discussion with the leaders of the associations.

The Education Minister gave an assurance to consider the matters relating to increase of teacher's subvention from 70 percent to 100 percent in phases keeping the financial position of the government in consider-

ation.

With this assurance, the leaders of the teacher's association said they do not object to the principle of realising their demands affecting the public examination and making examinees hostages and they are hopeful of solving their problems through discussion.

They also gave assurances of providing all sorts of cooperations to hold the coming SSC examination in a peaceful manner, the handout said.
