The inaugural session was addressed, among others, by Mr. Justice Mohammad Hossein, Prof Zillur Rahman Siddiqui, Prof. Kabir Chowdhury, Dr. Gazi A. Huq and Prof. Golam Samdani Quaraishi. Prof. M. Akhteruzzaman presided over.

After the inaugural session, a seminar on 'National Education Policy' was held in which Prof. Siddiqui read out the keynote paper.

In his keynote paper Prof. Siddiqui suggested formation of a non-government education commission. Those who participated in the discussion included Prof. Wahidur Rahman, Dr. Nurul Islam, Prof. Panna Kaiser and Prof. Mahbubul Huq.

The second seminar on 'rights and dignity of the teachers' was held under the chairmanship of Dr. Anisuzzaman. Prof. Ali Anwar of Rajshahi University presented the keynote speech. Dr. Moazzem Hossein, Dr. Rashid Al Faruqi Prof. Abdul Khalique, Prof. Jahanara Begum, Prof. Hossein Ali, Prof. Matiur Rahman, and Prof. Abdur Rahman took part in the discussion, among others.

On the second day of the conference, a 71-member new central committee was elected with Prof. M. Akhteruzzaman, Prof. Golam Samdani Quaraishi and Dr. Tajul Islam as President, General Secretary and Treasurer respectively.
