



DUCSU plan to end campus terrorism

The Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) on Saturday announced a month-long action programme demanding an end to campus terrorism, release of all student detainees and resignation of the present government.

Mr Amanullah Aman, Vice-President of DUCSU, announced the programme at a news conference at the National Press Club. Other DUCSU leaders including the General Secretary Mr Khairul Kabir 'Khokon' and Assistant General Secretary Mr Nazimuddin Alam were present.

The DUCSU as a part of the month-long programme will stage demonstration in front of the National Press Club on August 25, and hold a grand students' convention on September 16 to announce a country-wide, united and greater students movement.

The DUCSU would observe a month-long public relation programme from today (Sunday) and exchange views with various students' organisations, political parties and other professional organi-

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sations.

Mr Amanullah Aman criticised 'repression' on the leaders and workers of Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) in different parts of the country and demanded immediate and unconditional release of all student detainees including former JCD Secretary, International Affairs, Golam Faruq Avi.
