Shifts in primary schools

For want of a adequate number of schools (primary) in the capital city two three shifts are reportedly arranged sometimes in some Government Primary Schools. As a result, only roll calling and holding of examinations (3 times) every year can be performed in these schools. So the task of teaching is left to the private tutors mainly belonging to the same school. Poor students cannot afford the private tutors.

These schools should be run properly and we propose that two or even three shifts

may be held in the city Primary Schools but on the following arrangements:

Different shifts may be run by the same set of teachers or different set of teachers may be employed for each of the shifts.

In case the first method is followed the teachers are to be given some extra remuneration over and above their normal salary for working in extra shifts.

In case the second method is followed the teachers will be paid normally according to their fixed scale.

But more new primary (govt) schools should also be opened/sanctioned for the city.

We hope the govt. considers the proposal.

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
