JCD demands DUCSU polls

Leaders of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) at a rally on Monday reiterated their demand to announce immediate election date of Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU).

Addressing the rally JCD leaders alleged that the activists of pro-Awami League Chhatra League (S-P) who were afraid of contesting the election, with JCD, were trying to vitiate the congenial atmosphere on the campus by hiring armed hoodlums from different parts of the city.

JCD leaders described the atmosphere on the campus congenial enough for holding the election.

Condemning the terrorist activities of Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) on Rajshahi University (RU) campus on Saturday JCD leaders urged the students community to build up resistance against Shibir.

They also demanded of the RU authorities to re-open the University.

The rally, held in front of DUCSU office was addressed among others, by JCD President Fazlul Haq Milon, General Secretary Nazimuddin Alam, Senior Vice Presidents, Muniruzzaman Munir, Dhaka University Unit President A.B.M. Mosharrat Hossain and General Secretary Munir Hossain.

Earlier JCD leaders and workers brought out a procession on the campus chanting anti-violence slogans.

Meanwhile, central leaders of JCD called upon a press conference at DUCSU office at 5 PM today (Tuesday) demanding immediate announcement the date for holding DUCSU polls.
