Nasim Mohsin Scholarship Fund set up at DU

A memorial scholarship fund to perpetuate the memory of Shaheed Nasim Mohsin has been set up in the Department of English, Dhaka University, says a Press release.

At a simple ceremony held at the vice-chancellor's office on Sunday Mrs. Mohsin, mother of Shaheed Nasim Mohsin handed over a cheque for Taka 2 lacs to the Vice-Chancellor Prof Enajuddin Ahamed with a view to institute the memorial scholarship fund under the name "Shaheed Nasim Mohsin Scholarship Fund" in the English Department.

Out of the income from this money, 4 (four) scholarships at the rate of Taka 5000 each per

year will be awarded to 4 (four) meritorious but poor students of the said department on the basis of their examination results.

It may be mentioned that Shaheed Nasim Mohsin was a brilliant student and was studying in 2nd year BA (Hons) in English when he took part in the liberation war. He was killed by the Pakistan Army in November 1971 while fighting in the Comilla sector.

The function was attended, amongst others, by chairman of English Department Prof Fakhrul Alam, Dr. Ekram Hossain, Son-in-law of Mrs. Mohsin; Towhid Feroze, nephew of Shaheed Nasim and teachers of the English Department Prof Sadrul Amin; Dr. Showkat Husain and Syed Anowarul Huq.
