Unruly examinees gherao DU VC for four hours

A group of unruly examinees of Dhaka University on Sunday demonstrated in front of the Vice Chancellor office and damaged its window panes demanding re-arrangement of their examination schedule, reports UNB.

The Vice Chancellor Prof Emajuddin Ahmed was gheraoed for about four hours from 11 am by Honours and Master's degree students who demanded considerable gap in between their examinations.

Earlier, the university authorities have announced the examination schedule for the Honours and Masters degree examinations, beginning from October 17.
