DU admission test in 1st yr Hons classes begins today

Admission tests for the First Year (Hons) classes of Dhaka University (session 1995-96) under four units will begin from today (Thursday).

The test under 'Ga' unit (Commerce Faculty) and 'Gha' unit (combined group) will be held today (Thursday) and tomorrow (Friday) at 10 am respectively at different educational institutions in the city and the admission tests under 'Kha' unit (Arts Faculty) and 'Ka' unit (Science Faculty) will be held on May 17 and 24 respectively at the same time.

A total of 60 thousand applications have been submitted as against four thousand Dhaka University seats in the first year honours classes this year.

On an average, 15 students will have to contest for a seat in the admission tests this year, it is learnt.

Of the total forms, 20,900 have been submitted for 'Ka' unit (Science Faculty), 14,900 for 'Kha' unit (Arts Faculty), 14,500 for 'Ga' unit (Commerce Faculty) and 20,900 forms submitted for 'Gha' unit (combined group).

Specially the examinees will have to face tough competition in 'Gha' unit as 29 students will contest for a single seat under this unit and on the other hand the contest will be somewhat easy in 'Kha' unit. Nine students will contest for a seat under this unit this year.

Under the 'Ka' unit 16 students will fight for a seat while the same number of students (16 students) will fight for a seat under 'Ga' unit.

There are 4,000 seats under four units of Dhaka University. Of them, 1600 seats are under 'Kha' unit, 1300 under 'Ka' unit, 500 seats under 'Gha' unit and the number of seats under 'Ga' unit are 600 this year.

SEAT ARRANGEMENT
