Majority members of DU Senate stage walkout

Majority members of the Dhaka University Senate on Tuesday night staged a walkout in protest against the ruling of the Senate Chairman and Vice-Chancellor Prof. Emajuddin Ahmed over formation of a Senate Committee to investigate into alleged charges of corruption and financial irregularities, reports BSS.

The proposal to form such a committee was moved on the first day on Monday when the Senate special requisition meeting began with Prof. Emajuddin Ahmed in the chair.

Besides Monday's five hours' deliberations over the resolution moved by Senate Member Syed Ahmed, a good number of Senators on Tuesday took part in the discussion.

The Vice-Chancellor finally gave the ruling over the resolu-

tion saying that he needs time upto May 28 to obtain legal opinion including the opinion of the Attorney General over the formation of such committee.

The supporters of the resolution, however, made the walkout alleging that the Vice-Chancellor had resorted to a "time-killing" tactics with a motive to avoid formation of such committee. They further alleged that the Vice-Chancellor in support of a few Senate members actually tried to avoid the formation of the inquiry committee lest the irregularities committed during his administration came to public.

The Vice-Chancellor's ruling over the resolution created pandemonium as the Senate members, both supporting and opposing the move started shouting en masse.
