

and benefits to the makers of the future generation and crores of takas have been earmarked generously with a view to develop the standard of education from the primary stage so that our future generation can build their career in the right perspective for the glory of the nation. But the main objective, so far it has been assessed, has totally been defeated due to the reasons enumerated below :-

(a). Firstly, abolition of the Primary Centre Examination at the end of the primary classes. The teachers do not care as to whether the young learners have been able to learn read and spell any of the lessons as they can easily issue to any one a pass certificate of the primary education without any hindrance. As a result the students admitted in class VI in the neighbouring High Schools are found hopelessly weak in all subjects and sometimes they can not read or write in any of the languages.

(b). Secondly the primary teachers are mostly posted to the adjacent schools and they devote their time and

energy more to their agricultural or domestic works than to the teaching in the schools. In this way they lose their time and energy at home and they simply pass time at schools.

(c). Thirdly most of the primary teachers are less educated specially a particular section of them do not know Bengali properly but not to speak of English and Arithmetic. The S.S.C. passed teachers also do not know the technic of assessing the defects or weakness of the young learners for taking necessary remedy.

In view of the above position it is suggested that the Primary Centre Examination may be re-imposed. Teachers may be posted to the distant schools so that they can not exhaust their time and energy in their fields. Adequate measures may also be taken so that well qualified and able teachers are recruited in future.
