30 bombs recovered Caution against indiscipline in Dhaka varsity

The Dhaka University Syndicate at an emergency meeting on Monday cautioned the concerned students involved in indisciplined activities and non-student like dealings with the hall provosts, house tutors and returning officers on various grounds during the recent DUCSU and hall union polls.

The Syndicate cautioned that drastic measures would be taken against such students according to the university rule. Presided over by the Vice-Chancellor, Prof Abdul Mannan, the meeting reviewed the latest situation of Dhaka University.

The Vice-Chancellor also informed the Syndicate members of the recovery of 30 high powered bombs from the roof of Ziaur Rahman Hall in presence of the hall authority and Proctor of the University.

BOMBS RECOVERED

A special team of Dhaka Metropolitan Police recovered 30 high powered bombs from the roof of five storied Dhaka University Ziaur Rahman Hall. The bombs were kept in a sack near the water supply tank of the hall.

Hall Provost Prof A F M Khodadad Khan, Proctor of the University Prof Abdul Mannan Chowdhury and house tutors of the hall were present during the search.

The police also recovered some knives and iron rods from the hall premises. No body was arrested.
