

Call to reopen DU, hold exams during Ramzan

Combine of the nine students' organisations staged demonstration in front of the Dhaka University Vice-Chancellor's residence on Sunday demanding immediate reopening of the university and holding of all postponed examinations during the month of Ramzan.

The General Secretary of Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) Mr Mush-taq Hossain and General Secretary of Chhatra League (N-S) Shafi Ahmed addressed the students.

The student leaders held the Vice-Chancellor Prof Abdul Mannan responsible for what they said "patronising terrorism on the campus".

The student leaders also demanded trial and punishment of all the miscreants including the killers of Arif, Liton, Chunnu and attackers of the women students' procession.

Meanwhile, the DUCSU General Secretary in a statement on Sunday contradicted the statement of the Vice-Chancellor published in a section of the Press on Sunday. The DUCSU Secretary alleged that the Vice-Chancellor had no intention to reopen the university.
