DU likely to reopen Nov 15

The Dhaka University authorities are likely to reopen the dormitories and classes officially on November 15, according to reliable sources.

The members of the Syndicate, the highest decision-making body of the university, held a joint meeting with leaders of Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU), 22 student organisations and vice-presidents and general secretaries of the hall students' unions on Sunday, to take a decision regarding the resumption of academic activities and reopening of residential halls.

The meeting, with the Vice-Chancellor Prof. M. Maniruzzam Miah in the chair, however, ended without any decision.

According to the meeting, the Vice-Chancellor will meet the hall provosts at 12 noon today (Monday) and take a decision regarding reopening of the university and residential halls at a meeting of the Syndicate to be held at 4 pm on the day.

The student leaders have been requested to place their recommendations within the next two days regarding "how to ensure security of all concerned on the campus."
