

DU Senate session begins today

DHAKA June 26 (UNB) : The Dhaka University Senate will begin a three-day session tomorrow to consider the annual budget for fiscal 1990-91 with an estimated expenditure of nearly Taka 33 crore, university officials said.

University administration sources said that of the total estimated expenditure of Tk 32,94,42,144 in the proposed budget, 86.21 per cent was expected to come as government grants while the rest 13.79 per cent from the revenue income of the university itself.

The Senate budget session is likely to be attended by five students representatives, nominated by the Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU).

They are DUCSU VP Amanullah Aman, GS Khairul Kabir Khokon, Fazlul Haq Milon, Goutam Kumar Mitra and Moniruzzaman Monir.

After the opening day's deliberations tomorrow, the Senate session will be adjourned to resume on Saturday, sources said.
