Student bodies firm to resist move to amend Varsity Ordinance

The 22 students organisations in a joint statement issued to the Press on Wednesday protested the government move to amend the 1973 University Ordinance. The student bodies including the student fronts of Awami League and BNP expressed their firm determination to foil the government move.

They observed that for free academic practice in the highest seat of learning a democratic order was most essential. They demanded more autonomy for the universities.

They said that this parliament was formed through farcical polls. The student organisations said that this parliament had no right to amend a democratic order.

The student organisations felt that the government was plotting to

amend the University Ordinance to create dislocation in the universities for damaging the atmosphere of free, fair educational and intellectual practice.

The 22 students organisation further observed that it was a conspiracy to curb the autonomy and for banning student politics. Urging the government to refrain from taking this decision. The 22 party student organisation warned that any attempt in this regard would be resisted unitedly.
