## Vow to avert further crisis in DU

Provosts of all the halls, House Tutors, Proctors, leaders of Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) and All Party Students Unity (APSU) in a joint meeting with the Dhaka University Vice-Chancellor Prof M Maniruzzaman Miah on Friday vowed for working together in solving any kind of further crisis in the university.

Leaders of DUCSU and Hall Students Unions confirmed that they would identify the armed persons, if any, inside the campus well as the dormitories and arrest those with the help of the University authorities and members of law enforcing agencies.

The student leaders confirmed that they would immediately expel the arms monger members from their organisations.

Presided over by the Vice-Chancellor, the student leaders Amanullah Aman, Khairul Kabir Khokon, Mostafizur Rahman Babul, Nazmul Huq Pradhan and S M Kamal Hossain took part in the discussion.

Meanwhile, about 20 per cent

of the residential students of Dhaka University returned to their respective dormitories till Friday night.

The classes of the university resumed on November 14 following a 31 days' unscheduled closure and the dormitories were reopened for the inmates on November 13 morning.
