

DU classes resume on Sept 17

Classes of Dhaka University will resume on September 17 (Tuesday), according to an official announcement.

Students' dormitories will be reopened for the students at 10 a.m. on September 16.

Dhaka University Syndicate at an emergency meeting Saturday took this decision.

The university was closed on July 30 after a four-hour long gun-battle between two rival students'

organisations.

Presided over by Vice-Chancellor Prof M. Maniruzzaman Miah, the Syndicate urged the law enforcing agencies to ensure law and order on the campus with a view to avoid further armed clash between rival students' organisations.

The Syndicate called upon all concerned including political parties, different student organisations, guardians and people from all walks of life to extend their co-operation to wards restoration of congenial atmosphere on the campus.

However, the Syndicate observed that, although the situation was not favourable for reopening of the university, a decision to this effect had to be taken in view of the pressure from different quarters like the Syndicate, Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) and Dhaka University Education Atmosphere Council (DUEAC).
