

DU reopens soon

Dhaka University Syndicate on Sunday decided to reopen the university and students dormitories as soon as possible.

The syndicate at its meeting Sunday observed that reopening of the university and student dormitories would be decided through discussion with all concerned including the Teachers Association (DUTA) and the with hall authorities.

Presided over by Vice-Chancellor Prof M. Maniruzzaman Miah the Syndicate meeting urged the government to publish the whole report on the assault of Maulana Matiur Rahman Nizami, Parliamentary leader of Jammāt-e-Islami, the partial publication of which in some dailies has created confusion "in public mind."

The meeting categorically said that it was the responsibility of the government to maintain law and order in the campus. The government must bear this responsibility.

The meeting said that the environment will have to be created to enable the law enforcing agencies to work freely. The meeting, however called the law enforcing agencies for their neutrality in all their action on the campus.
