

DU peace rally today

The Dhaka University students teachers and employees will bring out a peace procession today (Saturday) with a call to maintain communal harmony in view of the historic Babri Mosque demolition and communal riots in India, reports BSS.

The procession to be led by University Vice-Chancellor will start from the Aparajeyo Bangla premises at 11 a.m, a university press release said.

The university offices and classes will remain closed between 11 am and 12 noon to facilitate the students teachers and employees in joining the procession.
