DU Syndicate's call to maintain peace on campus

Dhaka University Syndicate Monday called upon the students organisations and their followers to cooperate with the authority in maintaining the overall situation of the university smooth and normal, reports BSS.

The call was given at an emergency meeting of the Syndicate held Monday with Vice Chancellor Prof. M. Moniruzzaman Mia in the chair.

The Syndicate reviewed the incidents of March 28 and 29 and

expressed its deep concern at the serious situation arising out of it.

The meeting decided to take necessary steps through Discipline Council against the person responsible for the Sunday's incident.

It also condemned the incidents of harassment of the Provost of Zahirul Haq Hall, snapping the telephone line of his residence, ransacking his house, demand for his resignation, compelling him to go to the Police Out-post, firing towards the house of the Vice Chancellor and ransacking the University Club Building.

The Syndicate urged the students, teachers and employees of the university, law enforcing agencies and all sections of the people to help in freeing the campus from the outsiders and armed persons and maintaining educational atmosphere in Dhaka.

The meeting decided to hold a discussion meeting comprising Syndicate member, Teachers' Association, Deans, Provosts, Proctors and teachers' representatives in Senate on the method of freeing the campus permanently from arms.

Earlier, the Vice Chancellor apprised the Syndicate members of the police raid in Zahirul Haq Hall on the night of March 28 and on the morning of March 29 and arrest of the Hall's V.P., a student and two outsiders resulting in deterioration of law and order situation in the campus.
