DU uplift work stalled

The Vice Chancellor of trouble-stricken Dhaka University said on Thursday he can not sleep at night because of terrorism imported into the campus in petty political interest, reports UNB.

"I can not sleep at night because of terrorism, it's also not being possible to eradicate terrorism imported into the campus in a planned way in petty political interest," an impassioned Prof Moniruzzaman Mia told newcomers in the university.

Portraying a horrible situation in the Alma Mater at a freshers' reception, Prof Mia also said all development activities in the varsity had been stalled by the tyranny of terrorists and extortionists.

Tender for construction work has been floated time and again, but no contractor availed it for fears of the terror-mongers.

"I am moving with the money, allocated for development activities, into my pocket, as it can not be spent owing to terrorism," the VC said, urging the newcomers to take a vow to restore congenial academic atmosphere on the campus through a united resistance against the trouble-makers.

He also sought cooperation of all concerned in purging the university of all sorts of terrorism.

Pointing out various problems, the VC said session-jam could not be removed due to frequent shifting of examinations in the face of students demands. He told the students not to come to him ever again with the demand for shifting exam date.

The freshers reception of the Department of Psychology was held in the TSC auditorium.
