

# Sessions jam create chaotic situation in campus

Education Minister Mahbubur Rahman said in Dhaka on Monday that peace had to be maintained to sustain the pace of present development activities, reports BSS.

Speaking at the installation ceremony of Lions and Lioness Clubs Dhaka Premier, the Minister said "We need tolerance, proper education and brotherly

feeling for each other to become a prosperous and self dependent nation."

Referring to the present chaotic situation prevailing in the campus Mr Mahbubur Rahman said this could not be allowed to continue anymore.

He said the students in the higher level of education were

losing their precious academic years as because of session jams, created by the chaotic situation.

The Minister called upon all conscious people of the country to come forward and help the administration to get rid of such a situation. He said, 'we can not compromise with such a situation otherwise the struggle for independence would go in vain.'

The Minister said the government would make primary education universal and compulsory by 1990 and eradicate illiteracy by the 2000 if resource permitted. He said the government would spend taka 40 to 45 crore in next three years for the development in the educational sector.
