Dhaka Board may cancel 4 S.S.C centers

Dhaka Education Board is likely to cancel examination centres at Trishal, Bhaluka, Muktagacha and Sharishabari for large-scale adoption of unfair means.

According to a source in the Education Board, a proposal in this regard is going to be forwarded to the Ministry for approval.

the SSC examinations reached an alarming level. That even the Chairman and Controller of examinations of Dhaka Board could not enter Trishal examination centre on Monday.

When our chief photographer visited Trishal on Wednesday, the unruly mob gheraoed him for taking photograph of the copy-market outside the examination hall. Later police had to intervene to rescue him from the mob.

Examinees at Mirzapur centre under Tangail appeared the examination in free-style as the guardians and 'well-wishers' of the candidates forced the invigilators to leave the hall during Monday's examination.

Meanwhile, expulsion of 440 candidates was reported from different districts under Dhaka Board on Wednesday. Two invigilators of Sreebardi upazila were also expelled for supplying copies to the students.

Our Jessore Correspondent informed that a total of 951 candidates were expelled from different centres under the Jessore Board since the beginning of the examination on March 16. Of them 115 were expelled on Wednesday when the students completed their compulsory papers with Geography.

Report of no untoward incident was received from anywhere of the country on Wednesday.
