DU hall firing incident : call to try culprits

DHAKA, Aug 22 (BSS) : The Dhaka University Central Student Union (DUCSU) today demanded trial of the persons responsible for firing and other terrorist activities at Ziaur Rahman Hall last night.

DUCSU VP Amanullah Aman and GS Khairul Kabir Khokon, in a statement to the press, called upon the students to resist the terrorists and maintain peaceful atmosphere in the campus with patience and tolerance.

The DUCSU leaders alleged that the terrorists of an organisa-

tion had resorted to terrorism in the campus at a movement when the students had concentrated themselves in studies.

Our DU Correspondent adds : Supporters of rival student organisations, ransacked four rooms at two students dormitories of Dhaka University on Tuesday midnight.

The beddings of four seats were set on fire. The halls were Ziaur Rahman and SK Mujib halls.

Meanwhile different student organisations today (Wednesday) brought out processions and held rallies protesting against violence on Dhaka University campus yesterday.

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) and the Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL-N-S), brought out processions on the campus and held rallies. The JCD leaders blamed BCL (N-S) activists for the violence while BCL(N-S) held the JCD responsible for it.

UNB adds a joint meeting of Dhaka University authorities and student representatives this evening, resolved to maintain peaceful atmosphere on the campus and warned "terrorism will no more be tolerated".

Vice-Chancellor Prof Muniruzzaman Mia presided over the meeting attended by all faculty Deans, Hall Provosts, Proctor, Assistant Proctors, Vice-Presidents and General Secretaries of DUCSU and different hall unions and Presidents and General Secretaries of student organisations.
