

125th year of Jessore Public Library to be celebrated

The Jessore Institute, Jessore will celebrate the jubilee of the 125th year of Jessore Public Library and the International Year of the Child, 1979 in the last quarter of this month. The institute has chalked out an elaborate cultural programme in this regard. This will also mark the inauguration of a child and youth section and a regional Central Book Bank (first such bank on regional basis) on the first floor of the new library building and a 150-seat reading room with text books and reference on the second floor. With the inauguration of these sections the building space covered by the library, including its old building, will stand at about 8,000 square feet. The Jessore Institute which is the mother organisation of Jessore Public Library has been encouraging children in different sports and cultural activities in observance of the International Year of the Child 1979. The institute has made good arrangement for training children in table tennis and other indoor games and has recently established a science club for them. The institute has also been buying more emphasis on buying more books in the library for children in observance of the year.
