

Shahabuddin told of BAU students' problems

DHAKA, BSS: A nine-member delegation of the Central Students Union of the Bangladesh Agriculture University (BAU) Mymensingh, met the Acting President Mr. Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed at President's Secretariat here Wednesday.

The delegation, led by AKM Abdur Rafique, Vice-President of the Union, discussed with the Acting President various problems facing the students including accommodation transport and session jam.

The students delegation informed the Acting President that the university at present had only four buses. They also made special request for expansion of the present women hall as it cannot accommodate 450 girl students of the university. They also informed the Acting president that the construction work of the University Central Mosque, which was started long ago has not been completed as yet. The student leaders requested the Acting President to give special attention in this regard. They also urged him to arrange for providing an ambulance.

About employment facilities for agriculture graduates, the student leaders requested for filling.

up the existing vacant posts without delay by appointment on ad hoc basis as was done in the case of medical graduates.

They also demanded that there should be a special BCS examination only for the agriculture graduates.
