2,815 schools, madrasas to be developed this yr

A total of 2,815 high schools and madrasas all over the country would be developed during the current financial year, reports BSS.

Tenders for the development works of these institutions would be called this month and work-orders would be issued by November next, an official handout said.

This was decided at the 46th meeting of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on the Ministry of Education held at the Jatiya Sangsad Bhaban Sunday. Chairman of the committee, Education Minister Barrister Jamiruddin Sircar presided over the meeting.

Members of the committee, Md Amanullah Aman, Mashtur Rahman and Prof Mohammad Razaul Karim attended the meeting. Education Secretary Irshadul Haq, Secretary of Primary and Mass Education Division Kazi Raqibuddin Ahmad were present.
