

15 hurt as police, APSU activists clash in city

DHAKA, Nov. 24 (UNB) : At least 15 people were injured when police lathi charged a procession of the All Party Students Unity (APSU) near the busy Motijheel area today.

Five motor vehicles were also damaged after the APSU activists turned violent during the incident.

Witnesses said chase and counter-chase began when police halted the procession from the Dhaka University campus near the

Dainik Bangla crossing of the city and resorted to cane charge.

Two rounds of gun shots were also heard, they said.

Police lobbed several rounds of tear gas shells to disperse the mob.

Doctors at the Dhaka Medical College Hospital stated the condition of Samajtantrik Chhatra Front central committee member Ali Akbar and Krishna Prasad, a student of Dhaka University and BCL (H-A) activist, to be serious.
