APSU call to maintain poll discipline

The All-Party Students Unity (APSU) in a statement to the press on Monday called upon all concerned including the political parties and alliances to maintain strict discipline during the February 27 polls and help transition to democracy peacefully.

The APSU said that the students brigade, formed earlier to help and cooperate with the Election Commission and law enforcing agencies for peaceful holding of the polls, will formally start functioning from today (Tuesday) throughout the country.

The central committee of the brigade has been working at the DUCSU building of Dhaka University, while the district, upazila, and thana level committees will work at the district, upazila and thana levels.

BSS adds: The All-Party Students Unity (APSU) Monday called upon the political parties to conduct their activities in accordance with the code of conduct framed by the Election Commission for the coming parliamentary polls.
