

Education policy soon : Sadek

Education Minister ASHK Sadek informed the Jatiya Sangsad on Wednesday that the present government will formulate an education policy and work in this regard has already been initiated.

Replying to a question from Mirza Azam of Awami League Mr Sadek said there is no education policy in the country and education system is based on a combination of projects.

Replying to a question from Kazi Sirajul Islam of Awami League Mr Sadek said government expenditure on each of the cadet college student is Taka 45,953 annually as against Taka 2,028 for a student of non-government colleges in 1995-96 fiscal.

Responding to a question of Talukder Abdul Khaleq of Awami League Education Minister said from the period between 1991-92 and 1995-96 development work of 37,204 primary schools, 6,179 non-government schools, 367 non-government colleges and 98 government colleges was completed.
