

School dress fund to finance uplift of pry schools

The amount of Taka 18 and a half crore earmarked for the dress of students of primary schools will be spent to finance the project of universal primary education and development of primary schools in the country during the next fiscal year, an official handout said here on Thursday, reports BSS.

The primary school students would not, therefore, be given dress free of cost as the fund would now be utilised for construction, repairs, procurement of furniture and other facilities for education, providing better training to the students and overall development of the primary schools.

The handout said, the concerned authorities had reviewed project for providing dress to the primary school children free of cost wastage of money, possible corruption and problems relating to the timely supply of the dress were identified as bottlenecks of the project.

On the other hand, desired result of the project could be achieved by giving stress on subjects of priority in the primary education system.

However, according to previous decision of the Government an amount to Taka four crore was sanctioned for distribution of dress to the primary school children at the thana-level throughout the country during 1980-81. But this did not bring the desired result.
