Reopening of Islamic Varsity demanded

Pro-Awami League Chhatra League here Saturday demanded immediate reopening of the Islamic University and cleansing of the campus of trouble mongers, reports UNB.

The university was closed sine die on April 29 following the killing on the campus of a Pourashava Commissioner of Kumerkhali in Kushtia.

Addressing a press conference at Madhu's canteen of Dhaka University, leaders of the Islamic University unit of BCL also demanded that those responsible for the killing and terrorism on the campus be arrested and punished.

The BCL leaders said they will submit a memorandum to the Vice Chancellor on June 1 arrange meetings with politicians and professionals from June 2-7 and hold a rally on the campus on June 16 to press home their demands.

The press conference was addressed by BCL leaders, including Abu Syed Al Masud, Dipok Bhounik, Abdul Wadud Khakon, Afsar Ali and Mir Zillur Rahman.
