Authorities claimed a number of steps were taken by the Dhaka University to improve educational atmosphere. In January 1989, the Dhaka University authority declared that it would publish results within three months after any exami-

nation. But the promises remained promises. We fail to understand what prevented the authorities from publishing the results.

We would be grateful if the DU authorities could take necessary steps to publish our results and save us from the harassments and anxieties.
