## Need for collective efforts to remove illiteracy stressed

NOWABGANJ, May 28: State Minister for Textiles Abdul Mannan Friday underlined the need for collective efforts for eliminating the curse of illiteracy from the society by the year two thousand through best utilisation of scopes created by the government of Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia, says BSS.

The State Minister was speaking at a public meeting arranged on the occasion of foundation laying of the Dudghata Balukhanda High School here.

The State Minister opined that education is one of the basic rights for which the present government had been endeavouring to ensure the right of the people of the country and fulfil their basic requirements.
