

Girls high school at Brahmanpara needed

COMILLA: Brahmanpara upazila of Comilla district is lagging far behind in promoting female education since there is not a single girls' high school in the upazila with a population of 1,28,000.

Women's literacy rate in Brahmanpara still remains

only nine per cent which is much below the national rate.

The district Education office sources said, the responsibility of setting up of a new high school lies with the community of the respective area. The Comilla district Education officer said that the well to do people of the locality should come forward to establish a girls' high school in the upazila headquarters.

Non-availability of required land and want of required fund is the main problem for establishment of the a girls' high school at the Brahmanpara upazila, concerned people said.
