Govt urged to accept primary teachers' demand

Leaders of different political parties at a rally in Dacca on Wednesday at the Baitul Mukarram Square expressed their solidarity with the striking primary teachers and assured them of all cooperation in their struggle for realisation of a three-point demand, reports BSS.

Organised by Bangladesh Primary Teachers Association (Azad) in support of its three-point demand, the rally was presided over by Mr. Altaf Hossain, Acting President of the Association.
