

AL men shut college

Local Awami League leaders closed Kuripara College last week over a dispute regarding the appointment of a principal, resulting in suspension of academic activities and examinations.

Kuripara College, established Sirajganj Sadar in 1999, is not yet included in the MPO programme.

Acting Principal Rabiul Karim said Ratankandi union Chairman Golam Mostafa Khokan and union AL President Abdul Moktadir Bokul forced the managing committee to appoint a principal of their choice.

The AL men locked the college office on November 21 and the classrooms on November 26, halting all academic activities and exams, Rabiul said.
