

Khadiza's assaulter to be brought to book soon

Says home boss

Badrul Alam, who brutally hacked Sylhet Govt Women's College student Khadiza Begum Nargis in broad daylight, will soon be brought to book, Home Minister Asaduzzaman Khan Kamal said yesterday.

"The people of the country will see how fast the punishment for the perpetrator be ensured, as we have already arrested him and are going to take appropriate measures to expedite trial," he added.

Kamal was addressing as the chief guest the closing ceremony of the ninth national annual quality convention on education, organised by the Bangladesh Society for Total Quality Management and University of Asia Pacific on the latter's campus in the capital.

Badrul, a suspended student of Shahjalal University of Science and Technology (Sust) and an assistant secretary of Sust unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League, hacked Khadiza on her way home from college on October 3.
