APAC leaders blame govt, VC for CU crisis

CHITTAGONG, Apr 4:—The leaders of All Party Action Council (APAC) blamed the government and the Vice-Chancellor for being unable to resolve the student unrest now persists in the university.

The four leaders of APAC—Begum Khaleda Zia, Chairperson of BNP, Alhaj Hossain Mohammad Ershad, President of Jatiya Party, Professor Golam Azam, Ameer of Jamaat-e-Islami and Allama Azizul Huq, Chairman of Islami Oikya Jote said this while they were addressing a joint public meeting at Chittagong Outer Stadium today.

Professor Golam Azam said the Vice-Chancellor killed three activists of Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS), student wing of Jamaat-e-Islami, with the help of the police personnel. He demanded immediate reopening of the university.

Chairperson of major opposition party BNP, Begum Khaleda Zia blamed Awami terrorists for the Chittagong University crisis. She said the Vice-Chancellor of the university gave moral support to the miscreants. She demanded immediate removal of the VC and immediate resumption of classes.

The leaders of the four-party also blamed the university authorities for making the Chittagong University a Awami institutions.
