

2 BCL activists expelled for assaulting party colleague

Two activists of ruling party backed Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) were expelled from the organisation for assaulting one of their party colleagues at Surya Sen Hall Sunday night.

The expelled activists are Mohammad Amiruzzaman Jewel, a final year student of Library and Information Science Department and Amir Hossain Molla of Public Administration Department. Both are the residents of Surya Sen Hall.

A joint statement signed by the BCL DU unit president Sajjad Hossain and general secretary A.K.M. Amin said that they were expelled for their anti-organisational activities at the hall.

Lavlu, an activist of Mohsin Hall unit sustained injuries when his rivals attacked him at Surya Sen Hall Sunday night.

Meanwhile, BCL DU unit at an emergency meeting yesterday decided to observe the National Mourning Day on the campus in a befitting manner.

The BCL has taken up a month-long programme including discussion meeting and milad mahfil at all residential halls of the university and a photo exhibition on the life of Bangabandhu on August 15.
