Attested photocopy of certificates & marksheets of all examinations passed and one copy passport size attested photo of the candidate should be firmly attached with one copy of application. Another copy of the application & two self (postal) addressed envelopes (without postage stamp) should be so attached with pin or Jem's Clip as can be easily separated. No other application should be submitted at this stage. | |
