Subject: Regarding Graduate and Post-Graduate Scholarship: 1999-2000 Offered by the Government of Egypt

Applications are invited from Bangladeshi nationals for awarding scholarships at graduate and post-graduate levels 1999-2000 academic year fully on merit basis for the scholarships offered by the Government of Egypt. But no scholarship will be awarded in the subjects of Medicine, Pharmacy, Dental Medicine and Engineering and Technology. Candidates who can meet the following terms and conditions only can apply.

7	(a) Minimum 85% marks in average both in Secondary and Higher Secondary Examination separately for Science Group. (b) Minimum 75% marks in average both in Secondary and Higher Secondary Examinations separately for Commerce Group. (c) Minimum 75% marks in average both in Secondary and Higher Secondary Examinations separately for Humanities Group.
Post-graduate	
1	Should have 1st class in graduate or post-graduate examination in the subject concerned.
2	A person cannot be a candidate for more than one subject.
3	Candidate already selected for any other scholarship by the Ministry of Education need not apply.
4	If any candidate passing the higher secondary examination in science group applies for commerce group and if he has the subject concerned, then he will have to compete with the students of his own (science) group. Nomination will be given on the basis of total marks obtained in the SSC and HSC examinations.
5	If any candidate is nominated for scholarship of any country, he will not be considered a candidate for any other country.
6	Candidates nominated by the ministry primarily, will have to take part in a viva voce test in the Embassy of Egypt.
7	Candidates applied for scholarship at the post-graduate level will be nominated on the basis of 100 marks as per following rules and procedures after evaluation and on the basis of merit.
(a)	On the basis of marks obtained in SSC examination 20 marks
(b)	On the basis of marks obtained in HSC examination 20 marks
(c)	On the basis of marks obtained in bachelor examination 30 marks
(d)	On the basis of marks obtained in Master's examination 30 marks
8	If anyone obtains grade instead of marks in any examination, then a certificate regarding how much marks carry the concerned grade will have to be given.
9	Candidate must learn Arabic and he will have study in Arabic. The 6-12 months Arabic language course prior to beginning of main course for the selected candidates is also within the period of scholarship awarded by the Egyptian Government.
10	Finally selected candidates will have to bear the plane fare by himself for going to Egypt and come back home on completion of his studies. The Government of Egypt will bear all the expenses during his stay in Egypt.
11	The application candidate giving false statement, information will be treated as rejected.
12	2 (two) sets of application as per following table in English will have to be given. Certificates of passing both examinations, marksheet and passport size photograph attested by class I gazetted officer will have to be attached with one set of application. In other copy of application a similar attested photograph will have to be attached with the original application by a gems clip in such a way that two applications can be separated easily. There is no need to submit any other sort of application.

15. List of candidates selected provisionally for nomination will be hung at the No 5 Gate of Secretariat on 25-5-99 and prescribed forms will be disbursed among the candidates. No separate letter will be given to candidate. Those who will be selected provisionally by the ministry, will have to procure forms from the ministry immediately and submit again after filling it up.
