Admission tests on

7000 vying for 850 seats in 7 Ctg schools

CHITTAGONG, Jan 15: About 7000 students are vying for 850 seats in different classes as admission tests in seven main schools in Chittagong began today.

Over 900 candidates are vying for 45 seats in Class Six and Class Eight at Ispahani Public School and College. Seven hundred and twelve admission seekers are contesting for 40 seats in Class Six while 200 are contesting for 35 seats in Class Eight.

At Nasirabad Govt Boys' High School at least 1356 students are vying for 205 seats. Of them, 564 are vying for 105 seats in Class Five and 792 for 100 seats in Class Six.

For 120 seats in Class Four at Dr Khastagir Girls' High School, 1562 students took part in the admission test.

A total of 2082 students are vying for 230 seats at Chittagong Collegiate High School. Among them, 1474 are vying for 200 seats in Class Six and 608 for 30 seats in Class Nine.

At the Nasirabad Girls' High School, about 600 students are contesting for 120 seats in Class Six and at Chittagong Govt High School 712 students are vying for 100 seats in Class Five.

Meanwhile, 703 students are contesting for 67 seats in Class Five and Class Six at Bakulia Govt Boys' High School where 503 are vying for 60 seats in Class Five and 200 for only seven seats in Class Six.

Admission tests at Nasirabad Girls' High School, Chittagong Collegiate High School, Bakulia Govt High School (Class Six), and Nasirabad Govt Boys' High School (Class Six) will be held tomorrow.
