National education survey begins

A 15-day National Education Survey (Post-Primary), 1999 began yesterday to gather information on the educational institutions across the country as part of the government plan to improve the standard of education, reports BSS.

Bangladesh Bureau of Educational Information and Statistics (BANBEIS) is conducting the survey under the supervision of the Ministry of Education with financial assistance from the UNDP, which will continue till November 6.

The government has appointed 2,880 field workers and supervisors for successfully conducting the survey.

Assistant teachers, lecturers, assistant professors and associate professors from each school, college and university have been included in the survey.

Earlier BANBEIS conducted the survey in 1982 and 1993.

Meanwhile, Bangladesh Bureau of Educational Information and Statistics (BANBEIS) organised a training programme for the field workers and co-ordinators of the survey.

As part of the programme, 64 district education officers across the country have already started work as co-ordinators of the survey.
