No class or examination was held and no IU vehicles plied.

position BNP, called the strike in protest against dropping out of the name of late President Ziaur Rahman as founder of IU from the university's 1999 pocket diary published by the authorities.

After that they called for 72-hour strike from today in support of their demand.

BNP expressed solidarity with the strike call and urged the vice-chancellor to meet the demand immediately.
