Professional Masters in International Relations (PMIR)

Programme Features

This eighteen-month accelerated professional degree programme features: (a) three-semester format, duration of each semester being six months; (b) 12 course units consisting of 48 credit hours; (c) research module on International Relations; and (d) classes from 6:30 pm to 9:30 pm on weekdays and other suitable weekend hours.

Application Requirements

Applications are invited from individuals holding a Bachelor's degree in any discipline from any recognised university with at least 2nd class or a CGPA of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale)/3.0 (on a 5.0 scale) in their academic careers.

Applicants who have successfully completed Post-Graduate Diploma in International Relations (PGDIR) offered by the Department with a CGPA of at least 3.0 may directly get admission into the programme.

The PMIR programme provides a comprehensive understanding on a wide range of academic and policy issues of contemporary relevance in international and regional politics, security and economy. It is suitable for professionals and aspirants to prepare themselves in grabbing opportunities at the global level.

Admission Procedure

- Application forms to be collected from and submitted to the Office of the Department of International Relations on working days (from 10:00am-4:30pm) at a cost of Tk. 1,000 during **2 May - 2 June 2016**.
- Written test for admission will be held on **10 June 2016 (Friday) at 10:00 am**.
- The admission test is designed to evaluate candidates' qualitative aptitude, English language proficiency and analytical ability.

- Admission test results will be announced in mid-June, 2016.
- Successful candidates must be enrolled by 30 June 2016.
- Classes of 1st semester will commence from mid-July, 2016.
