## Shibir units at DU: Forged seals of provost recovered

Five forged seals of the provost of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Hall of Dhaka University were recovered from a room of the hall yesterday.

The seal of the provost is used for allotment of seats.

Some Chhatra League activists at the hall led by Talukder Ahsanul Kabir Polash also recovered some papers containing the names of members of a 41-member Islami Chhatra Shibir unit at the hall, party attendance book, money receipt and other documents from room no. 506, belonging to one Taher.

The recovered materials were handed over to the provost of the hall.

Some alleged ICS activists, who are resident students of the hall, were also held by the Chhatra League activists but were later released when the hall authorities intervened.

Sources said that during interrogation, they disclosed that there were ICS committees at some DU dormitories and their activities were regulated from Kataban mosque and Retina and Focus coaching centres. They also disclosed that Akhter, a former student of Social Welfare now working at Retina Coaching Centre was President and Shahjahan, a student of Arabic, was General Secretary of the ICS DU unit.

According to the papers, the 41-member unit at the Bangabandhu hall includes Kashru, a student of Islamic Studies (President), Reza, second year student of Political Science (General Secretary), Parvez (Joint Secretary) and Amjad Hssain, hall unit Commander.

Talking to The Daily Star last night, hall provost Prof. Md. Abdul Aziz said, "As a hall provost, I can not expel anybody for political reasons. But I will take stern action against those who forged the seal of hall authorities."

When contacted, BCL President Bahadur Bepary said, "We will never allow any activity of anti-liberation forces like Shibir on the campus."
