

DU may hold postponed exams on Fridays

Dhaka University authorities are planning to hold its various examinations on Friday to cope with the session jam being created due to the frequent hartal call by the political parties.

Vice Chancellor of Dhaka University disclosed this at a press conference at his official residence Monday afternoon. The press conference was arranged to brief the newsmen about the preparations on holding the forthcoming 40th convocation of the university.

"The session jam at the university had come to almost an end following various steps taken by the authorities to perform academic activities on time," the VC said but regretted that the session jams has increased recently due to the frequent calling of hartal.

The DU had to remain closed for 10 days since November 1 till Monday. Almost 200 examinations of various departments of DU has been postponed for unavoidable reasons.

Sources said that a section of university students submitted a memorandum to the DU authorities to hold the examinations on Friday.

DU authorities will have to reschedule the postponed examinations which will take at least three months, official sources said.
