

8 held for using unfair means in Sust exams

The Shahjalal University of Science and Technology, (Sust) authorities yesterday handed over eight people, including five admission seekers, to police for using unfair means during the test for admission to the university.

They were held with 14 mobile phones which looked like calculators. Of them, Ishrat Imtiaz Hridoy, law student of Jahangirnagar University, and Al Amin, food engineering and tea technology student of Sust, are associated with a racket which is being run by "Google Coaching Centre" of Bagura and were providing the admission seekers with answers, said Akter Hossain, officer-in-charge of Jalalabad Police Station.
