

## CU classes resume today

CHITTAGONG, May 30: Classes of Chittagong University resume tomorrow after half a month of unscheduled closure, reports UNB.

The CU Syndicate at meeting today with Vice Chancellor Abdul Mannan in the chair decided to reopen the University.

The University was closed on May 15 after a student was killed in a gunfight between Islami Chhatra Shibir and Chhatra League. The deceased, Jubair, was a final year student of Economics Department and a Shibir activist.

On May 21, Chhatra Shibir, the student wing of Jamaat, called for an indefinite strike in the University to protest the killing.

It called off the strike today after a dialogue with a liaison committee, formed to create congenial academic atmosphere through discussion with student organisations. The committee today submitted its report to the Syndicate.
